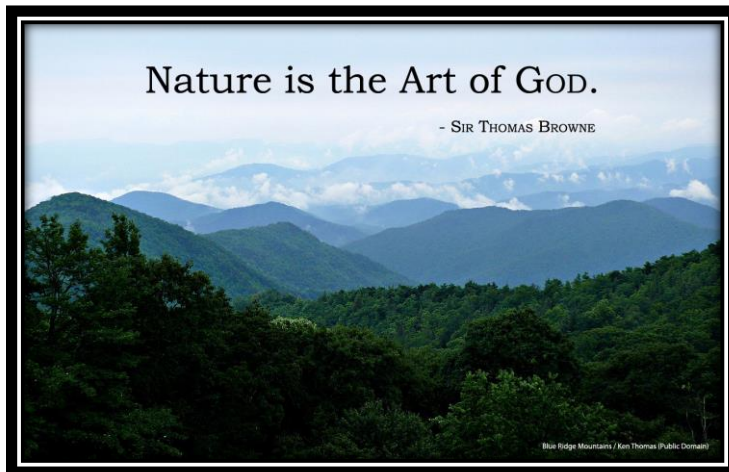
OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD - AUGUST
