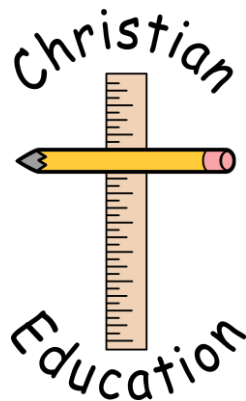
WOMEN'S PRAYER GROUP
