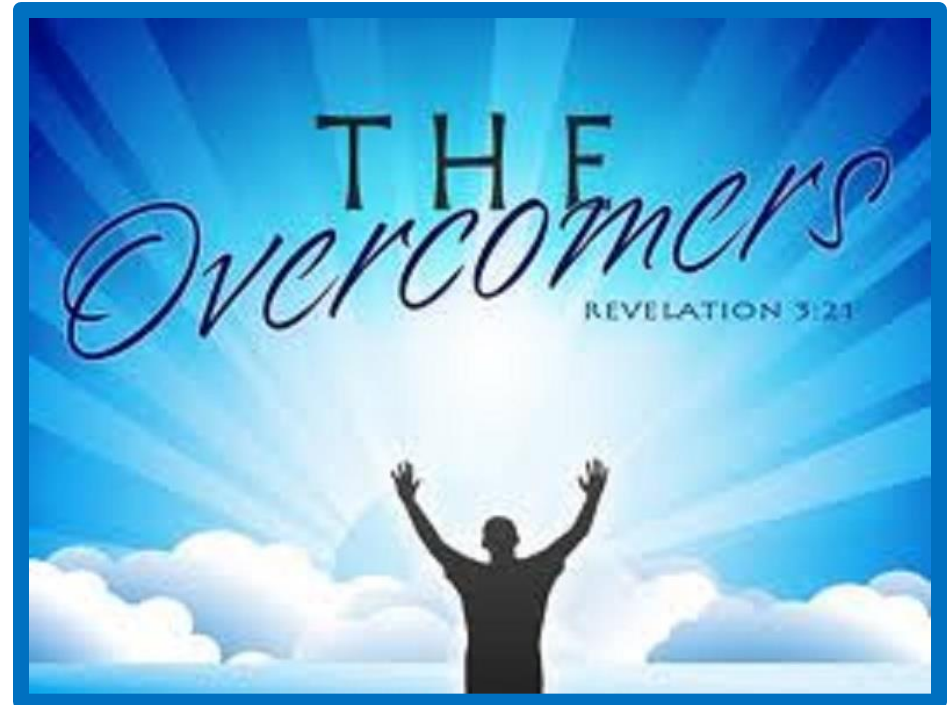

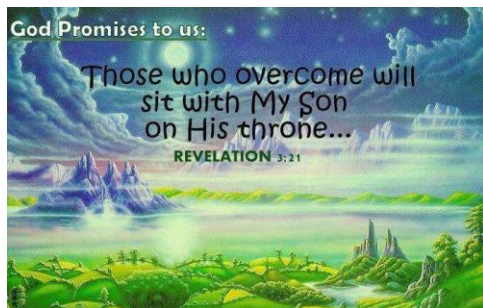
OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD
