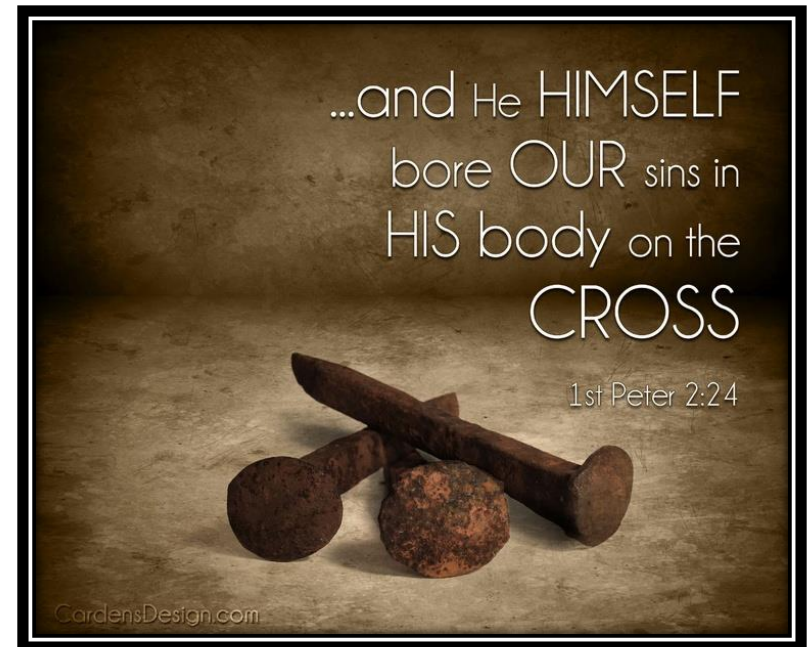

From the Pastor’s Heart

As Easter approaches this Sunday, I’d like to challenge you with a question: **What does the resurrection of Jesus mean to you? Is it central to your faith?** There is irrefutable evidence for Jesus' resurrection. What I’ve learned is that both Christians and atheists agree that the resurrection is *the central issue to Christianity*. If the resurrection were not true then we are still in our sins, and following Christ is meaningless! Both believers and non-believers agree that *if* Jesus rose from the dead then we have an intellectually feasible argument that the claims of Christianity are true. If he didn’t, then all of Christianity falls. The Good News is...as Hymn 251 says:

*We serve a risen Savior, He’s in the world today;
We know that He is living, whatever men may say;
We see His hand of mercy, we hear His voice of cheer,
And just the time we need Him He’s always near.
He Lives, He lives, Christ Jesus lives today!*

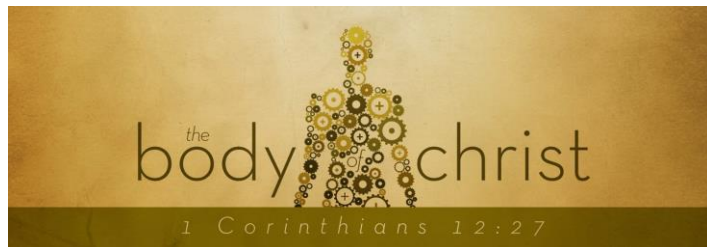
