Come to Fort Walla Walla Museum to hear the story of what life was like for the first Sabbath-keepers in the Walla Walla Valley. Learn about the obstacles and challenges they had to overcome, and the events that led to the first churches being established, as well as the beginning of Walla Walla College. The story will be told from the perspective of 4 key individuals who played prominent roles in the establishment of the first Adventist churches. Kristen Fry will play Augusta Moorhouse, the very first Sabbath-keeper (and Sabbath-promoter extraordinaire!) to come to the Valley, Gladys Wentland plays Caroline Maxon Woods, a local musician, Bob Sepolen plays William Nichols who had a key role in securing land for the first church, and Ken Devereaux plays Aaron Miller of the vast Miller Nursery in Milton-Freewater during that era.

You will enjoy hearing about the Adventist history that we want to preserve for future generations.
