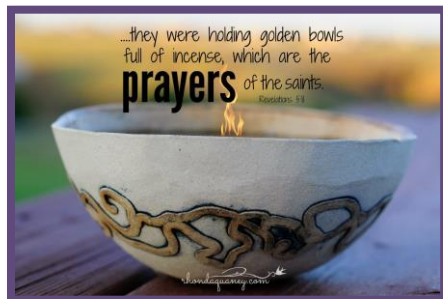

Landscape Renewal Project

The new plants for landscaping around the outside of our Church and Fellowship Hall have been ordered and are scheduled for delivery about September 16. It will take approximately 170 plants to do the job. That may seem like a lot of plants but they will be a smaller plant than we have had in the past and easier to maintain and very attractive from what I've seen. **Plants and landscaping are donated as a memorial to Sam LeFore.**

We felt like our church members would also like to be included in this memorial by helping to set the plants and ground cover. This work would have to be hired out unless we can help to do it ourselves. Within the next two weeks we will be having a work session at the church to prepare the planting area. Please bring a rake – hoe – shovel, etc. to prepare the area around the Church and Fellowship Hall. Martin Coronado is working on the irrigation system to bring it up to date.
