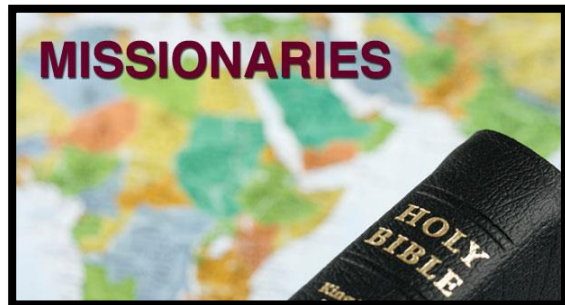
## COLLEGE PLACE SPANISH CHURCH
