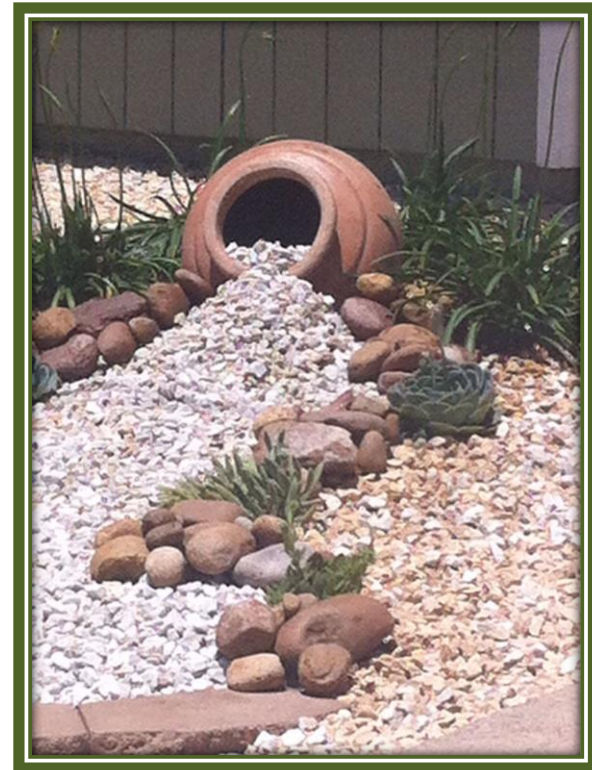

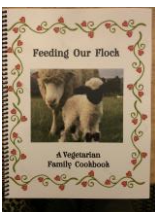

## 100<sup>TH</sup> BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION TODAY



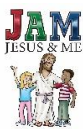
