100 YEARS BIRTHDAY

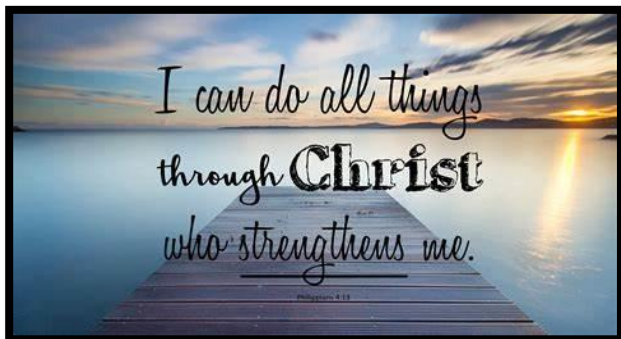


WOMEN'S MINISTRY RETREAT
