Pastor's Message:

Jesus said, "When the Son of Man comes in His shining-greatness, He will sit down on His throne of greatness. All the angels will be with Him. All the nations of the earth will be gathered before Him. He will divide them from each other as a shepherd divides the sheep from the goats. He will put the sheep on His right side, but the goats He will put on His left side.... Then they will go away to eternal punishment, but the righteous to eternal life" (Matthew 25:31-33, 46).

On the Judgement Day, Jesus will divide the sheep from the goats—the saved from the unsaved. Does the thought of that frighten you? Do you fear that day because you know you’ve sinned? Do you fear it because you don’t think you can measure up to what God expects? Because you think you haven’t been "good enough?"

Let these next words from Jesus in John 3:17 bring you comfort and assurance: "For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn world, but to save the world through him."
