One of the greatest symbols in the Bible of the Moral & Redemptive Purpose of Prophecy is of Jesus as "the Lamb." The apostle John, who wrote the Gospel of John and the book of Revelation, is the only Bible writer who specifically calls Jesus the Lamb: Two times in his gospel--"look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world," and then 28 times in the book of Revelation!
