I like how the Message Bible paraphrases Colossians 3:13-14:

"So, chosen by God for this new life of love, dress in the wardrobe God picked out for you: compassion, kindness, humility, quiet strength, discipline. TOLLGATE TORNADO FAMILY NEEDS HELP



BIBLE STUDY



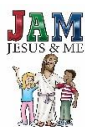
